

## **FULL TIME PLASTIC SURGEON - Cornwall, Ontario**

The Department of Surgery, Cornwall Community Hospital is seeking a full-time plastic and reconstructive surgeon with fellowship training in hand surgery and an additional area of clinical focus including Breast and reconstructive surgery. Compensation is fee for service, billed to OHIP. Equitable access to Operating room and Ambulatory Clinics would be provided. Certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, as well as licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is required.

Cornwall Hospital provides a full range of acute inpatient, outpatient and community mental health services to their catchment area of 100 000 people from the communities of Cornwall, the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry and to the Mohawk Community of Akwesasne. With 160 beds, more than 1000 employees and 110 physicians. Cornwall Hospital offers a wide range of care and services. These include emergency, surgical, medicine and rehabilitation services, mental health and addiction programs as well as a family birthing centre.

Cornwall is situated along the St. Lawrence River, an equidistant 60-minute drive to Ottawa (our tertiary care referral centre) and Montreal. Our hospital has recently completed renovations including a new Emergency Department, modernized 6 theatre operating rooms, a closed 11-bed Intensive Care Unit staffed by Intensivists/Internists, and a fully integrated Electronic Health Record. Advanced Diagnostic Imaging Services include both CT and MRI, and Interventional Radiology is readily available via our tertiary referral centre. CCH is a satellite teaching hospital affiliated with the University of Ottawa School of Medicine as well as Queen's University.
