



## PLASTIC SURGEON

Dalhousie University, in conjunction with the IWK Health Centre is seeking a full time academic plastic surgeon. The IWK Health Centre is the largest women's health centre and sole tertiary care pediatric hospital in the Maritime provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island, serving a catchment area of more than 1.8 million people. The Plastic Surgery Division within the Department of Surgery, Dalhousie University is a fully accredited Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada training program with full involvement in undergraduate, postgraduate and continuing medical education programs.

The position is a unique one, with the successful applicant expected to be engaged in clinical activity both at the pediatric and women's sites of the IWK. He/she should have fellowship training in microsurgery and breast reconstruction to support the IWK's expanding Breast Health Centre. Although not required to apply, the successful candidate should also indicate a commitment to pursue additional fellowship training in pediatric upper extremity surgery. He/she should show evidence of interpersonal and collaborative skills and initiative to further advance the clinical and academic productivity of the Division of Plastic Surgery. A full-time appointment at the appropriate level in the Department of Surgery, Dalhousie University is required and will be available to the successful applicant. A commitment to surgical education at all levels is essential, as well as active participation in research and academic initiatives of the Plastic Surgery Division and the Department of Surgery.

Applicants must have a Fellowship in Plastic Surgery (or equivalent), and be eligible for Certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensure in the Province of Nova Scotia. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be considered first for this position. Dalhousie University is strongly committed to employment equity within its community and to recruiting a diverse faculty and staff. The University encourages applications from all qualified candidates including women, persons with disabilities, First Nations, Métis and Inuit persons, members of racialized communities and LGBTQ-identified persons.

Applications must include an up-to-date curriculum vitae, and a description of previous academic experience, as well as of specialty training. Applications will be accepted until September 15, 2017. Submissions may be made to:
