



Re: <u>Mentor Breast Reconstruction Fellowship</u>

<u>Division of Plastic Surgery, University of British Columbia</u>

This advanced training program is 6 months in duration and provides a large volume experience in immediate and delayed alloplastic and autologous breast reconstruction. Although a significant portion of the reconstruction is microvascular in nature, this is not a microsurgical fellowship. Rather, this is a comprehensive breast reconstructive fellowship for plastic surgeons that have completed their training and wish to develop/refine subspecialty skills in the management of breast and trunk reconstruction. Due to the short duration of the fellowship, this training program is most appropriate for practicing plastic surgeons, although recent graduates will be considered.

Successful completion of a Royal College or American Board certified Plastic Surgery program or equivalent.

Generous financial support is available for the 6-month duration.
