Sault Area Hospital (SAH) is a new state-of-the-art facility opened in 2011. With approval for 293 inpatient beds and with 14 Intensivist led ICU beds, SAH provides emergency, primary, secondary, selected tertiary and long-term care healthcare services to the city and the District of Algoma with a catchment population of approximately 115,000.

The surgical program performs 5200 surgeries per year and supports 6 operating rooms daily. Surgical services include General, Vascular, Orthopedic, OB/Gyn, ENT, Plastics, Urology, Ophthalmology and Dental.
