

The Fraser West Plastic Surgery group and the Fraser Health Authority is looking to hire a plastic surgeon to join our group of ten surgeons. The ideal applicant will have at least one year of post-graduate training in microsurgery. It is expected that the applicant will have a strong interest in tertiary and quaternary microsurgery reconstruction, including trauma, breast, and Head and Neck. They will be responsible for establishing a microsurgery program for the Fraser Health Authority at Surrey Memorial Hospital.

Surrey Memorial Hospital and the Jim Pattison Out Patient and Surgery Centre are part of the Fraser Health Authority, B.C.'s largest and fastest growing health authority. Current Head and Neck reconstruction is managed along with ENT. The breast health program sees about 250 to 300 patients a year for immediate reconstruction, the majority of which are currently implant based. Protected microsurgery time will be made available at the hospital, along with elective resources at the Jim Pattison Centre, including day care surgery, ambulatory care and a hand clinic.

The group is affiliated with the University of British Columbia with teaching opportunities for medical students and residents, though this is not a primary residency training site. Multiple private clinics also offer resources in the area. The successful applicant would join five surgeons at their office in Surrey.

General plastic surgery call is currently 1 in 10. A MOCAP agreement provides an on call stipend. Call is shared with the Royal Columbian Hospital group covering a level 1 trauma centre.

Surrey is one of the fastest growing cities in Canada and is expected to become BC's largest city in the next ten years. It is located a half-hour from Vancouver or the natural beauty of the Fraser Valley. It is an ideal location to raise a family with a seemingly unlimited number of recreational activities, fine restaurants, and top schools. With its proximity to Vancouver and BC's Interior, this is a great place to live.
