University of British Columbia, in conjunction with Johnson & Johnson Canada, is offering a 6 month Breast Research Fellowship focused on outcomes research in the field of breast reconstruction or breast cancer specific research. The fellow will work closely with surgical colleagues, a dedicated research assistant and will work under the guidance of the breast reconstruction surgeons at the University of British Columbia. Training in the field of research design/epidemiology and statistics is beneficial but not required.

The fellowship can potentially be combined with the Breast Reconstruction Fellowship at UBC, providing a 12 month comprehensive training experience in the surgical and research aspects of breast reconstruction.

Generous financial support is available for the 6-month duration.

Applications are now being received for upcoming positions. Please apply ~ 24 months prior to the desired date of training. Applicants are generally accepted 18-24 months prior to the January or July start date.
