The Department of Surgery and the Section of Plastic Surgery at the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg Canada, invite applications for a Locum Surgeon in the Section of Plastic Surgery. The term of this Locum is June 1, 2018 to May 31, 2019. There is a potential for permanent employment but this is not at the present time guaranteed.

Remuneration is derived from Fee for Service. The position encompasses inpatient and ambulatory patient care responsibility and tertiary care medicine. The Program incorporates a rich mix of emergent and elective Plastic Surgery, focusing on hand, wrist and peripheral nerve. It will be at the Victoria Hospital and Pan Am Clinic primarily. Consulting and operating at multiple sites in the city will also occur. The position is an academic position with resident assigned to the surgeon 3 days per week. The position includes the resources and responsibilities currently allocated to the present upper extremity Plastic Surgeon including clinic, operating time, call and teaching.

Candidates must have specialty qualifications in Plastic Surgery in the country of current practice, and must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Fellowship training in hand Surgery is preferred.

The University of Manitoba and the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority are committed to creating a diverse and inclusive workplace. Applications are encouraged from qualified applicants including members of visible minorities, Aboriginal peoples, people with disabilities, people of all sexual orientations and genders, and others who may contribute to the further diversification of the University.
