Dr. Douglas Courtemanche and Dr. McGregor Alton will receive CSPS Lifetime Achievement Award





THE CSPS LIFETIME Achievement Award for the year 2005 is given to Dr. Douglas Courtemanche and Dr. McGregor Alton in recognition of their outstanding achievements in plastic surgery and of their service to the CSPS.

Canadian plastic surgeons, we are aware that their "Founding Fathers" and "Pioneer Surgeons" were located in Central Canada. Less is generally known about the pioneering plastic surgeons who moved West.

DR. DOUGLAS COURTEMANCHE was recruited back to Vancouver by Dr. Robert Cowan following his postgraduate training at the University of Toronto, University of British Columbia and in Great Britain. Doug Courtemanche continued with the de-

In Memoriam Patricia A. Clugston, MD, FRCSC



DR. PATRICIA CLUGSTON, one of the greats of Canadian Plastic Surgery, passed away on March 1, 2004 at the age of 46.

Patty was a native of British Columbia, who grew up at the foot of the Coast Mountains in North Vancouver. As a young woman, she became an out-

standing skier and went on to excel on Canada's junior national team. At university, while pursuing a demanding academic curriculum, Patty found time to play on UBC's varsity soccer team and the ski team. She was also an excellent tennis player, and as an adult, became a tournament winning golfer.

Patty graduated from the Faculty of Science at UBC in 1981 and from Medical School in 1986. She went on to a Rotating Internship at St. Paul's Hospital in Vancouver, a year of General Practice, and then her Plastic Surgery Residency at UBC, graduating in 1993. During her residency, Patty developed an in-

terest in Breast Reconstruction, and decided to pursue a breast fellowship in Nashville Tennessee. Following a very successful fellowship year she returned to Vancouver to begin practice in January 1995 as part of the Division of Plastic Surgery at the University of British Columbia.

Almost immediately upon her return to Vancouver, Patty took over the fledgling plans for what was to become the UBC Hospital Immediate Breast Reconstruction program. This program was an instant success, and quickly

expanded under her guidance to supply a coordinated approach to immediate and delayed breast reconstruction for approximately 200 women per year.

Along the way, Patty always had a strong interest in medical education. In 1998, when the UBC Plastic Surgery program began accepting fellows, Patty became the Division's first Fellowship Director. From humble beginnings, Patty developed an independent fellowship in Breast Reconstruction which now trains individuals from around the world. That same year, she was appointed to the UBC resident selection committee, and in 2002, she became the Resident Program Director. In honoring Patty's commitment to teaching, she was the recipient of the most prestigious award for post graduate teaching at UBC in all specialties, the Professional Association of Residents award for excellence in 2003.

Patty was also an outstanding clinical researcher, who in a brief 10 year career was able to make important contributions to the literature of her field. She authored 16 articles and 2 book chapters, and she was always in demand as a guest speaker for medical and lay audiences alike.

For the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, Patty was a highly respected editor of written questions, and in 2002 she was a Royal College examiner.

As an administrator, Patty was decisive and productive. From 1998 until 2002, she acted as the Medical director for Plastic Surgery at the UBC hospital. She was a member of numerous organizations, including the CSPS, CSAPS, ASPS, and ASAPS. Perhaps her favorite, however, was the Northwest Society of Plastic Surgeons, an organization whose annual meetings afforded her an opportunity to ski, play tennis, and play golf, and to beat most of her male colleagues in the process. Patty held numerous posts with the Northwest Society, and at the time of her death was the first woman president in the 42 year history of that organization.

Patty lived life to the fullest, and carried on with her career and her extracurricular activities long after having been diagnosed in 2002 with Scleroderma. Struck with an especially virulent form of the disease, Patty practiced the profession she loved until she was finally hospitalized in September 2004.

Patty Clugston was a much loved individual, whose friends, colleagues and patients gathered on a sunny March 12th, to celebrate her remarkable life. She will be forever remembered as a clear thinking, ethical surgeon who always had the sixth sense to do the right thing. To her patients,

Patty was a hero, who was committed to excellence, but who never lost the common touch. To her many friends, she was just Patty, a humble achiever, with a keen wit, and a pragmatic approach to life, who would never let ego get in the way.

Patty is survived by her husband, Stuart Clugston, her parents, Roy and Gladys Whittle, and 5 brothers and sisters.

Tragically, Canadian Plastic Surgery has lost one of its shining stars in the prime of her career. Her legacy is secure and will live on as an example for other young surgeons wishing to maintain a rich personal life, while pursuing an academic career at the highest possible level.

Development of plastic surgery in British Columbia with outstanding, tireless, selfless dedication. He enhanced the scope and stature of plastic surgery in both the service and academic areas. In 1969, he established one of the largest and most progressive burn units in Canada. In 1972, he founded the plastic surgery residency training program at UBC in addition to writing in the areas of hand, burn, maxillofacial and pediatric surgery, a special passion for him. His efforts and accomplishments were not confined to the local scene. In 1983 he was President of the CSPS when the Society hosted the IPRAS quadrennial congress. He was Chair of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Examination Committee (1981-83), and was elected to the Council of the College in 1982. This led him to the Presidency of the College (1992-94). This achievement was important not only locally and nationally, it was recognized internationally and deservedly brought him many honors.

He was acting Chair of the Department of Surgery at UBC in 1988 and was appointed Associate Dean and Head of Post-graduate Surgical Training in 1989. Dr. Courtemanche retired in 1994 as Professor Emeritus. He now spends his time with his wife Ann, his garden and his antique cars.

Alberta. After a brief stint in the Navy he attended the University of Alberta receiving his M.D. in 1951 and M.Sc. in 1954. After post-graduate work in the U.K., Montreal and New York with William Littler, he obtained his Fellowship in Plastic Surgery in 1958 and then came on staff at the University Hospital in Edmonton. He quickly attracted a staff of well qualified Plastic Surgeons to his service and within a few years was instrumental in establishing the Division of Plastic Surgery, the Cleft Palate Clinic and the Firefighters' Burn Treatment Unit at the University Hospital.

He was the Director and Head of the Training Program of the Division of Plastic Surgery from its formation in 1965 to 1986 and was the Firefighters' Burn Professor of Surgery from 1985 to 1991 when he retired. He was appointed Professor Emeritus in 1992.

Dr. Alton's published papers and presentations were in the fields of Transplantation, Trauma and Burns. He had a special interest in Burns of the Hand and also avulsion and bear injuries.

He generously contributed his talents as a member of the Specialty and Examination committees in Plastic Surgery of the Royal College and served as Chief Examiner from 1978 to 1980.

He was president of the CSPS in 1971 and President of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta in 1980. Dr. Alton was a member of the Board of Directors of the Edmonton Eskimo Football Club for 6 years.

Dr. Alton and his wife Jane, have 5 children and 13 grandchildren. His hobbies are gardening, golf and woodworking.
