## Canadian Plastic Surgery residents eligible for ABPS Exams

IN DECEMBER 2006, Dr. **Don Lalonde**, Chair of the Royal College Plastic Surgery Specialty Committee wrote to inform Canadian Plastic Surgery Program directors and members of the RCPSC specialty committee of a decision reached by the American Board of Plastic Surgery (ABPS). The text of that letter follows.

"It is with pleasure that I am writing to inform you that on Wednesday November 7, 2006, the American Board of Plastic Surgery (ABPS) voted in favor of allowing future graduates of Canadian Plastic Surgery residencies to be eligible to sit for the American Board of Plastic Surgery written and oral (certifying) examinations and to gain certification with

ABPS, with certain provisos. The provisos are:

- 1) That the Canadian trained plastic surgeon must be a graduate of a Liaison Committee for Medical Education (LCME) approved medical school in the United States or Canada;
- 2) The Plastic Surgery residency program must be accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in Canada;
- 3) The resident must have entered plastic surgery residency through the Canadian Residency Match Program (CaRMS);
- 4) The plastic surgeon must hold a full and unrestricted State or Provincial license in Canada or the United States.

5) The plastic surgeon must have successfully attained certification in Plastic Surgery by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons in Canada.

The retroactive group of Plastic Surgeons who graduated from Canadian Plastic Surgery programs before 2007 may also be eligible to sit for the American Board of Plastic Surgery examinations and certification. In order to be eligible, this group must also comply with all 5 of the provisos stated above if they were accepted into a Canadian Plastic Surgery training program in or after 1993 when the

## In Memoriam

The Canadian Society of Plastic Surgeons regrets the passing in recent months of three of its most senior members.

**Dr. Norman Merkeley** passed away in November 2006 at the age of 88 years. Dr. Merkeley had been a member of the CSPS since 1949. He was a front line surgeon during World War II and put his abilities to the service of the impoverished and unfortunate on numerous medical missions over 30 years in many countries including Malaysia, Vietnam, Jordan, Afghanistan and Nepal.

**Dr. Jacques Doray** joined the CSPS in 1965. He graduated from the Université de Montréal in 1957 where he also took his postgraduate training. Dr. Doray was President of the Society in 1974. Dr. Doray died in April 2007.

**Dr. John Keyzer**, a graduate of the University of Toronto program, became a member of the Society in 1975. He retired from practice in 2005. Dr. Keyzer passed away in September 2006.

The Society's condolences go out to the families of these members whose passing is regretted by their colleagues and friends in the plastic surgery community.

As Clinical Professor of Surgery, Les continues to teach medical students and residents and is the recipient of teaching awards. He has been a visiting professor on courses and Resident Research Days in Canada and is recognized internationally as a teacher as far as Indonesia and Afghanistan.

CaRMS matching service was instituted. For those who were accepted into a Canadian Plastic Surgery training program before 1993, the CaRMS proviso does not apply. The retroactive plastic surgeon may be required to be reviewed by the ABPS Credentials and Requirements Committee. In addition, the retroactive group will be required to satisfy the Professionalism Requirements of the Maintenance of Certification Program in Plastic Surgery (MOC-PS) during the application process prior to taking the examinations in addition to having satisfied the above provisos.

The Professionalism requirements include:

- 1) Unrestricted state or province medical license;
- 2) Verification of active Hospital privileges in plastic surgery;
- 3) Three Peer Review Forms (one must be from a Chief of Surgery or Chief of Staff);
- 4) Membership in one of the 20 Sponsoring Organizations of the Board (CSPS membership is one of the 20 organizations);
- 5) Accreditation Certificate from Outpatient Surgical Facilities if applicable.

It is important to note that those who take the ABPS exams and get their ABPS certification must continue with the Maintenance of Certification (MOC-PS) process in order to keep their certification valid. MOC-PS means that they must complete professionalism, education and practice performance modules every three years and an examination every 10 years.

The first step is completion of a Residency Registration/Evaluation Form which is available on the Boards website."

As a result of this award, the paper was presented a second time in Puerto Rico at the American Society for Peripheral Nerve Surgery meeting on January 13, 2007. The paper went on to receive the award for the best resident paper at the AAHS meeting in Puerto Rico.

tired from active practice as Associate Professor in the Section of Plastic Surgery at the University of Manitoba in 2005.

During his career, he was actively involved in provincial, national and international societies. These include American College of Surgeons, ASPS, AAPS, ASAPS and of course the Canadian Society of Plastic Surgeons, where he was local arrangements host of the 1975 meeting, Secretary - Treasurer in 1976-79 and President in 1980-81.

Perhaps one of his greatest assets was his ability to see important trends in Plastic Surgery. Dr. Waters was instrumental in founding the Western Surgery Center approx 25 years ago. This was the first private surgical center in Manitoba and one of the first in the country. Arguably, his most important contribution to the Society was to be the founding President of the Educational Foundation of CSPS from 1982-86. The important role that the Educational Foundation has come to take within the CSPS may not have been foreseeable but the Canadian plastic surgery community is grateful to Dr. Waters for this important initiative.

Dr. W. Reid Waters is a Plastic Surgeon who has always cared for his family, his patients, and his specialty.
