The Section provides specialized care in all aspects of Plastic Surgery including trauma and burn care. The Division of Plastic Surgery, Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry at the University of Alberta has a busy, and comprehensive training program in Plastic Surgery.

The successful applicant will have a job descriptions which includes a commitment to clinical care delivery, education, and research. The successful applicant will have opportunity to practice the full spectrum of Burn Surgery in a busy tertiary care institution; working cooperatively with a multi-disciplinary team. It is anticipated that the applicant will have demonstrated training and expertise in the complete care of the burn patient with skills including: burn and wound care management, and intensive care training.
