Plastic Surgery Locum Opportunity

Cambridge, Ontario

The Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery in Cambridge, Ontario is inviting applications for a full-time locum position from January 1, 2021 to July 31, 2021. The start date is flexible and could begin anytime in February 2021 instead.

The candidate will join a highly collegial team of two plastic surgeons and one orthopedic hand surgeon providing comprehensive care in Cambridge, which is located exactly one hour between London and Toronto. This opportunity includes an office with full-time administrative support and EMR/billing support, a large network of referring physicians, and an already established waitlist.

The locum will have access to a full schedule of regular hospital resources as follows:

- 4-5 main OR days per month
- 2 minor surgery days per month (sometimes divided into half-days)
- 2-4 fracture clinic half-days per month, staffed with dedicated nurses/cast technicians

Though the practice is skewed towards breast reconstruction and applicants with fellowship training in alloplastic and microsurgical autologous breast reconstruction are strongly encouraged to apply, such expertise is not essential for this locum position, as the scope of practice is diverse and also otherwise includes a wide spectrum of common elective surgical cases (e.g. breast reductions, dupuytren's disease and carpal tunnels, skin cancers, etc.).

On-call duties are equitably divided and provided to the Cambridge Memorial Hospital (i.e. not regional call) with a frequency of ~1 in 4. The on-call stipend will be provided at 100% to the locum. Also, there is no research or teaching obligation or expectation associated with this position.

The candidate must hold a fellowship in Plastic Surgery with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and must hold an independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario.
