

**Plastic & Reconstructive Surgeon
St. Michael's Hospital, Unity Health Toronto**

The Division of Plastic Surgery at St. Michael's Hospital, Unity Health Toronto is inviting applications for a permanent full-time position for an Academic Plastic Surgeon. The anticipated start date is flexible with a target of summer / fall of 2021, or earlier.

The successful candidate will provide care for patients involving all aspects of plastic surgery and develop a clinical focus in their practice consistent with their area of subspecialty training or experience. Graduate level training is highly valued. Applicants pursuing fellowship training in 2021-2022 are invited to apply with start date appropriate to completion of training.

St. Michael's Hospital is a downtown teaching and research hospital, affiliated with the Department of Surgery at the University of Toronto. We are a Level 1 Trauma Centre and Plastic Surgery is intimately involved in the care of soft tissue injuries, maxillofacial trauma, and hand injuries. There is a breadth of the type and complexity of the cases we see at the hospital and we serve as a provincial tertiary referral center for reconstructive surgery. There are currently three Plastic Surgeons within the Division.

The candidate must possess exemplary clinical skills and professionalism, with evidence of excellent interpersonal and collaboration skills. The candidate will be required to support the division of plastic surgery with teaching commitments and will regularly be involved in the training of plastic surgery residents, medical students and fellows.

The successful candidate must be proficient in English and be eligible for appointment at the University of Toronto. Certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada as well as licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is a requirement.

Compensation is through fee for service with OHIP billings, division practice plan, and on-call stipend with an expected salary in the range of \$300,000 - \$400,000 annually.
