The University of Alberta invites applications for a 6 or 12-month fellowship in hand, wrist, peripheral nerve and microsurgery. This program will provide comprehensive training in surgery of the hand and upper extremity. The fellow will become proficient in adult and pediatric hand and wrist surgery, peripheral nerve surgery and microsurgery of the extremities. Spanning two tertiary and three community hospital sites, this fellowship offers a high-volume experience including acute hand/wrist trauma, replantation, brachial plexus injuries, and secondary reconstructive procedures of the upper extremity. The fellowship is administered through the Division of Plastic Surgery.

Academic activities include a formal didactic curriculum, case conferences, journal club, and a formal microsurgery animal training course. The fellow will be expected to complete an original research project under the supervision of one of the attendings.

Applicants should have certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Plastic Surgery or Orthopedic Surgery. Applicants must be eligible for a license for independent practice in Alberta.
