

UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO AESTHETIC SURGERY FELLOWSHIP

The Division of Plastic, Reconstructive & Aesthetic Surgery at the University of Toronto, is offering a one-year clinical fellowship in Aesthetic Surgery starting **July 1, 2022**. The deadline for applications is **May 1, 2021**.

The Aesthetic Surgery Fellowship is designed to encompass the full depth and breadth of Aesthetic Surgery including facial rejuvenation surgery, rhinoplasty, breast and body contouring surgery, and female cosmetic genital surgery. Additionally, the fellow will gain experience with minimally invasive and nonsurgical treatments including energy-based therapies, injectables, and skin care. The Fellow will gain experience in practice management and the business of aesthetic surgery. The Fellow will work on a daily basis with Dr. Jamil Ahmad, Dr. Frank Lista, and Dr. Ryan Austin at the Plastic Surgery Clinic. Fellows will also rotate regularly at ICLS Dermatology & Plastic Surgery with Dr. Julie Khanna, Dr. Sheetal Sapra, and Dr. Maryam Saheb-Al-Zamani, as well as with Dr. Derek Ford and Dr. Lawrence Tong. There will be opportunity to spend time in other practices in the Greater Toronto Area.

There is dedicated time for the Aesthetic Surgery Fellow to manage patients with the senior resident in the Resident and Fellow Aesthetic Clinic. This will involve performing consultations, procedures and postprocedure care, as well as on-call coverage for these patients.

A formal didactic education program includes weekly Resident and Fellow Aesthetic Clinic case conference, as well as monthly journal club, practice quality assurance meetings, and Division of Plastic, Reconstructive & Aesthetic Surgery rounds. Fellows are expected to complete clinical research during their training. Fellows will have the opportunity to attend the annual meeting of the Canadian Society for Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (CSAPS) and the annual Aesthetic Meeting of the Aesthetic Society.

The Division of Plastic, Reconstructive & Aesthetic Surgery at University of Toronto is responsible for training residents in Plastic Surgery, and the fellow will be expected to participate and support this education endeavor. The fellow may have the opportunity to participate in general plastic surgery call. Salary is provided at a PGY4 level.

Interested applicants are expected to have successfully completed residency training in Plastic Surgery and must be eligible for an Independent Practice Certificate of Registration from the College of Physicians and Surgeons in Ontario (CPSO) by the start of the fellowship. Malpractice insurance will be required through the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA).

Interested applicants should send a current curriculum vitae, a personal statement outlining why you want to pursue aesthetic surgery training (limit 500 words), and 3 letters of reference. All application materials may be sent by email to the fellowship supervisor, Dr. Jamil Ahmad.
