

Breast Reconstruction Fellowship, Western University

The Division of Plastic Surgery at Western University is accepting applications for a 12-month fellowship beginning July 1, 2023.

This 12-month fellowship will offer trainees the experience to develop skills in a broad spectrum of oncologic and non-oncologic breast reconstructive techniques. This is a comprehensive breast reconstruction fellowship including post-oncologic reconstruction with microsurgical autologous, alloplastic based, and oncoplastic reduction approaches. We are a high-volume centre and provide a unique experience for a breast reconstruction fellowship in Canada. We work closely in a multi-disciplinary team with our breast oncologic surgeons and have a high volume of immediate breast reconstructive cases. The fellowship will also include experience in the breadth of non-oncologic breast surgery including trans-gender top surgery techniques, and cosmetic breast surgery.

The applicant must have successfully finished residency training in plastic surgery from a recognized plastic surgery training program. The fellow will need to be licensed for independent practice in plastic surgery by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). Salary information will be provided on request.
