

## Plastic Surgeon: Full-time position

Fraser Health is responsible for the delivery of hospital and community-based health services to over 1.9 million people in 20 diverse communities from Burnaby to Fraser Canyon within the traditional, ancestral and unceded territories of the Coast Salish and Nlaka'pamux Nations, which is home to six Métis Chartered Communities.

The Fraser West Plastic Surgery group and the Fraser Health Authority is looking to hire a full-time Plastic Surgeon to join our group of eleven surgeons. The ideal applicant will have at least one year of post-graduate training. It is expected that the applicant will have a strong interest in general plastic surgery, including management of trauma, hand and/or wrist, breast, skin cancers and microsurgery.

Royal Columbian Hospital (RCH) and Eagle Ridge Hospital (ERH) are part of the Fraser Health Authority, BC's largest and fastest growing health authority. RCH is a level 1 trauma center and sees a high volume of plastic surgery trauma cases. Resources will be made available at RCH and ERH, including inpatient surgery, day care surgery, dedicated trauma time, ambulatory care, outpatient clinic and a hand clinic. There are also opportunities to perform MSP cases in private facilities.

Our division members are affiliated with the University of British Columbia with regular teaching opportunities for medical students and residents, though this is not the primary residency training site. Multiple private clinics also offer resources in the area.

General plastic surgery call is currently 1 in 11. A MOCAP agreement provides an on-call stipend. Call is shared with the Surrey Plastic Surgery Group and covers Surrey Memorial Hospital.

New Westminster and Port Moody are both in close proximity to Vancouver and multiple neighboring cities such as Coquitlam, Burnaby, and Surrey. All are great locations to raise a family with a seemingly unlimited number of recreational activities, fine restaurants, and top schools.
