The ideal applicant will have at least one year of post-graduate training. It is expected that the applicant will have a strong interest in General Plastic Surgery, including management of trauma, hand and/or wrist, breast, skin cancers and microsurgery.

Surrey Memorial Hospital (SMH) and the Jim Pattison Outpatient Surgery Centre (JPOCSC) are part of the Fraser Health Authority, BC's largest and fastest growing health authority. The Plastic Surgery group receives approximately 800 referrals per week. Resources will be made available at SMH and at JPOCSC, including inpatient surgery, day care surgery, ambulatory care, outpatient clinic and a hand clinic. There are also opportunities to perform MSP cases in private facilities.

The group is affiliated with the University of British Columbia with teaching opportunities for medical students and residents, though this is not a primary residency training site. Multiple private clinics also offer resources in the area. The successful applicant would join six surgeons at their office in Surrey.

General plastic surgery call is currently 1 in 11. A MOCAP agreement provides an on- call stipend. Call is shared with the Royal Columbian Hospital group covering a Level 1 trauma centre.

Surrey is one of the fastest growing cities in Canada and is expected to become BC's largest city in the next ten years. It is located a half-hour from Vancouver or the natural beauty of the Fraser Valley. It is an ideal location to raise a family with a seemingly unlimited number of recreational activities, fine restaurants, and top schools.
