Opportunity

We are seeking a full-time plastic surgeon to join the surgical team at St. Martha's Regional Hospital.

The service currently manages pathology of the hand, breast, head and neck, facial trauma, skin including melanoma, chronic wounds, minor burns, other. Some aesthetic surgery is possible. An interest in general reconstruction is an asset. OR and ambulatory clinic time is available, as is office space attached to the hospital with administrative support. Affiliation with Dalhousie University with an option to participate in research and surgical education at the undergraduate and postgraduate level is possible.

Estimated Annual Salary: \$300,000 to 350,000

St. Martha's Regional Hospital serves a population of nearly 40,000 from Antigonish, Guysborough, and surrounding communities, but the plastic surgery service draws upon all northeastern Nova Scotia, which has a population of about 210,000 from New Glasgow eastward. With approximately 90 beds for all in-patient care, Plastic Surgeons at St. Martha's are joined by our colleagues in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine (general and subspecialty), Geriatrics, Hospitalists, Psychiatry, General Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Ophthalmology, Otolaryngology, General Surgery, Radiology (U/S, CT, MRI, ECHO), Palliative Care and visiting Oncology and Neurology.

Community based care is further supported by a men's and women's health centre, chronic pain clinic, methadone clinic, and youth clinic at the local high school. Physicians and all staff at St. Martha's Regional Hospital take great pride in providing high-quality care to patients and value collegiality in the workplace. Also, St. Martha's Regional Hospital has the most active cross-specialty, accredited Continuing Medical Education (CME) program in the province.
