



LOCUM BURN SURGEONS

Hamilton Health Sciences is seeking two Locum Burn Surgeons. The HNHB LHIN (4) Burn Program serves a catchment area of more than 2.5 million residents. The service provides tertiary and quaternary level care to patients within the catchment area. The Hamilton General Site houses the Regional Burn Unit, and the Regional Trauma Centre.

The successful applicant's clinical skill set must include the full spectrum of **acute burn care and burn reconstruction**. A Fellowship training in Burns is required. The successful applicant will be expected to show evidence of interpersonal and collaborative skills and initiative to further advance the clinical and academic productivity of the Burn Program.

Applicants must have a Fellowship in Burns, Certification in Plastics or General Surgery from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent, and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply. However, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be considered first for this position.

Applications must include:

- A curriculum vitae.
- Description of previous academic experience, as well as specialty training.
- Provide the names and contact information of three professional referees; letters of reference are not required and will not be reviewed at the application stage; the Department will request letters of recommendation from referees at later stages of the search process.
