

Academic Plastic Surgery Position

The Division of Plastic Surgery at St. Michael's Hospital, Unity Health Toronto is inviting applications for up to two permanent full-time positions for Academic Plastic Surgeons. The anticipated start date is flexible, with a target start date of summer or fall 2023.

St. Michael's Hospital is fully-affiliated with the Temerty Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto. St. Michael's Hospital is part of a network of institutions that together comprise Unity Health Toronto (UHT). UHT is committed to care of the disadvantaged. The successful candidate must hold a Fellowship in Plastic Surgery recognized by the Royal College of Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent) and hold, or be eligible for an independent practice license from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. The successful candidate will be a Plastic Surgeon with recognized subspecialty fellowship training that will supplement and enhance expertise already held within the Division.

The candidate will have completed, or be working towards a Master's or Ph.D. degree in a relevant field and will be eligible for an appointment University of Toronto at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor.

Excellence in clinical care, a record of academic achievement, and a commitment to teaching and mentorship are pre-requisites. A demonstrated record of professionalism and collaboration is required and a key feature of the Department of Surgery. The successful candidate will contribute to the academic mandate of the Hospital and University through scholarship, education, and creative professional activities.

St. Michael's Hospital is a downtown teaching and research hospital, affiliated with the Department of Surgery at the University of Toronto. We are a Level 1 Trauma Centre serving the Greater Toronto Area and beyond. The Plastic Surgery division is intimately involved in the care of patients with soft tissue injuries, maxillofacial trauma, and upper extremity injuries. The Division serves a wide breadth and complexity of patients. The Hospital is provincial tertiary referral center for reconstructive surgery. Members of the Division of Plastic Surgery provide care in all aspects of plastic surgery, while maintaining a clinical and academic focus in a specific subspecialty area.

The University of Toronto is strongly committed to diversity within its community and especially welcomes applications from persons of colour, women, Indigenous / Aboriginal People of North America, persons with disabilities, LGBTQ2S+ persons, and others who may contribute to the further diversification of ideas.
