Fun for All-ages

1. Mini Golf

A miniature golf course, open from mid-May to mid-October, features a ten-hole traditional course that is fun for the whole family. Rates are \$3.50 per child, \$5.50 per adult or \$12 for a family pass (2 adults and 2 children). Putters are available from the resort office directly across from the course which is located at Riverside RV Resort and Campground, 3 km north of Whistler Village.

2. Disc Golf

Think golf, played with frisbees. There are two disc golf courses in Whistler. An 18-hole course is located at Whistler RV Park and Campground with discs available at the main office. The Whistler Disc Golf Course is 27 holes and stretches from Spruce Grove Park to Lost Lake Park. It's a combination of wooded and open terrain with lots of challenging elevation changes. Bring your own discs or rent some in the Village. Don't forget the bug spray!

5. Suggested outings

River of Golden Dreams pedal & paddle combo

5 hours, \$158 pp

Experience the best of both worlds with our River of Golden Dreams Pedal and Paddle Combo Tour. Our combo tours begin and end at our Whistler Village location and combine a paddling adventure with a bike ride to and from Alta Lake along the leisurely paved Valley Trail or more-advanced single track mountain bike trails. On this tour, you will pedal to Alta Lake on one of our mountain bikes, then paddle across Alta Lake, through the Whistler Wetlands and down the scenic glacial river aptly-named 'The River of Golden Dreams'. Your bike will be waiting for you at the end of your paddle for you to explore some local mountain bike trails before riding back to the village. Choose to embark on this Pedal and Paddle Combo tour with your own private adventure guide on a Private Guided Tour, join in on a Guided Group Tour or take the plunge and explore on your own terms on a Self-Guided Tour (prior paddling and biking experience required).

Learn about Whistler's unique alpine flora, fauna and geology on a Private Guided Tour or on a public Guided Group Tour. Private Guided tours (minimum 2 people) are guaranteed exclusive, and include hotel pick-up and drop-off. Guided tours are public with a minimum 4 people to run the tour. Guided hiking tours start from our Whistler Village location.
