Our facility is newly built in 2021 and includes a modern, beautifully appointed clinic with 7 examination rooms, minor procedure room and a state-of-the-art Non-Hospital Surgical Facility with an operating theatre, three recovery beds and in-house medical device reprocessing. Our full-service plastic surgery practice is open Monday to Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Heated underground parking is included. This locum opportunity is a great fit for a new or experienced plastic surgeon who is looking to practice the breadth of plastic surgery while enjoying the mountain lifestyle. Dates are flexible with the possibility of long-term appointment.

### **Qualifications:**

Eligible candidates will hold an MD, have completed an accredited plastic surgery residency and hold a Fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Plastic Surgery. Fellowship training in hand/wrist surgery or breast surgery are an asset. The successful candidate will also be required to have active CMPA coverage and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta and EMR/Connect Care training on arrival.

### **Responsibilities:**

The successful candidate will be required to provide the full spectrum of community plastic surgery care with a focus on breast and upper extremity reconstruction as well as aesthetic surgery. Expertise in wrist (carpal) reconstruction is beneficial. Clinical responsibilities include coordinating and participating in the team-based care of patients presenting to Radiance Plastic Surgery and the Banff Mineral Springs Hospital. The successful candidate will have access



to the Radiance Plastic Surgery clinic with two full time registered nurses, operating room resources at the Banff Mineral Springs Hospital (1-2 days per week) as well as private operating room resources at Radiance Plastic Surgery's Non-Hospital Surgical Facility. The individual will be required to provide community call coverage as required by the Section of Plastic Surgery (50/50 split with Dr. Laliberte).

In accordance with Canadian immigration requirements, priority will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada. Radiance Plastic Surgery is committed to employment equity and respect, appreciate, and encourage diversity.
