Fraser Health Authority is seeking a part-time community plastic surgeon at 0.5 FTE for Langley Memorial Hospital. The ideal candidate should possess a minimum of one year of post-graduate fellowship training. They should demonstrate a keen interest in various aspects of general community plastic surgery, including trauma, breast, and skin cancer management. This position will complement the existing 1.0 FTE plastic surgeon at Langley Memorial Hospital.

Langley Memorial Hospital, a part of the Fraser Health Authority, is currently undergoing renovations and expansions to meet the needs of its growing community. Resources for plastic surgery, such as access to elective operating room time and ambulatory care/cast clinics, will be provided. Additionally, there are opportunities to conduct MSP cases in private facilities.

The surgical team is affiliated with the University of British Columbia, offering teaching opportunities for medical students and residents, although Langley Memorial Hospital is not a primary residency training site. Various private clinics in the area also offer additional resources.

General plastic surgery on-call duties are currently at a ratio of 1 in 5, with an on-call stipend provided through the MOCAP agreement. On-call responsibilities are shared with the Fraser East call group, which covers a level 1 trauma center and other hospitals in the Fraser East region.

Langley is in one of the fastest growing regions in Canada. It is located a half-hour from Vancouver and in the natural beauty of the Fraser Valley. It is an ideal location to raise a family with a seemingly unlimited number of recreational activities, fine restaurants, and top schools. With its proximity to Vancouver, the mountains, oceans and lakes, and BC's Interior, this area is a great place to live.
