reconstruction.

Requirements:

Financial support for this fellowship requires that the applicant be eligible for licensure

(Canadian trained) in Nova Scotia.

Successful completion of a Royal College or American Board Certified Plastic Surgery Program

or equivalent is required.

Successful completion of the <u>IELTS</u> exam if language of instruction and practice during medical school and residency was not in English. A passing grade must be obtained **prior** to submission

of the fellowship application.
