Breast Reconstruction Fellowship Director

Description:

Dalhousie University Division of Plastic Surgery offers a 12-month Breast Reconstruction Fellowship.

This advanced training program is 12 months in duration and provides an experience in immediate and delayed alloplastic and autologous breast reconstruction. Although a significant portion of the reconstruction is microvascular in nature, this is not a microsurgical fellowship. Rather, this is a comprehensive breast reconstructive fellowship for plastic surgeons that have completed their training and wish to develop/refine subspecialty skills in the management of breast and trunk reconstruction.

Requirements:

Financial support for this fellowship requires that the applicant be eligible for licensure (Canadian trained) in Nova Scotia.

Successful completion of a Royal College or American Board Certified Plastic Surgery Program or equivalent is required.

Successful completion of the IELTS exam if language of instruction and practice during medical school and residency was not in English. A passing grade must be obtained **prior** to submission of the fellowship application.
