

Plastic Surgery Position at Joseph Brant Hospital

The Division of Plastic Surgery in the Department of Surgery, at Joseph Brant Hospital (JBH) has an immediate need for a Plastic Surgeon. There is an opportunity for this to be either a locum position or full time position, if a continued need is identified. The position will participate within the regional call model. Resources will be made available to meet the needs of the position and specific details will be discussed with the selected candidate.

JBH is a busy, full service teaching community hospital servicing the City of Burlington with a population of 175,000. The Surgery Program performs approximately 11,000 surgical operations each year. Plastic Surgery is one component of our comprehensive surgical program including Vascular, Gynaecology, Orthopaedics, Urology, Ophthalmology, Otolaryngology, General Surgery and Dental. Our hospital has a 24 bed closed ICU with dialysis, a Cancer Centre and an Emergency Department with more than 50,000 patient visits per year.

Competence/interest in breast reconstruction surgery is required. Collegiality and the ability to provide an excellent patient experience is essential. As a community teaching campus of McMaster University, candidates will be expected to participate in a teaching commitment. Registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and fellowship with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada are required.
