Halton Healthcare – Milton District Hospital is currently seeking a full time **PLASTIC SURGEON** to join a dynamic surgical team in Milton. The successful applicant will join a collaborative Plastic Surgery division at Halton Healthcare comprised of three community hospitals in the growing urban and rural communities of Halton Hills with a catchment area of over 400,000 people. Halton Healthcare is undergoing a large organizational change as we strive to provide exemplary care for the population in the fastest growing communities in the Greater Toronto Area and in Canada. One Halton Healthcare is a transformational initiative designed to integrate care across our three hospitals (Georgetown, Milton, and Oakville) and nine community sites in response to projected population growth, increasing demand for services, and the need for more equitable access to care.

The Division of Plastic Surgery currently consists of one Plastic Surgeon at Milton District Hospital and five Plastic Surgeons at Oakville Trafalgar Memorial Hospital who also provide support at Georgetown Hospital. There is a full complement of general surgery, gynecology, orthopedic surgery, otolaryngology and urology specialists. Advanced diagnostic and interventional radiology services are available. The position offers access to weekly hospital operating room time, minor procedures, and fracture clinic space supported by Hand Therapists and departmental support for additional resources as the clinical practice grows.

The successful applicant will be expected to provide general plastic surgery care including skin, breast, hand and emergency surgery. A candidate with subspecialty expertise in breast reconstruction, including microsurgery, is an asset to support our growing community and well-established breast reconstruction program. The candidate would be supported by the existing group of Plastic Surgeons to collaborate in performing microsurgical procedures, where on average 3-4 DIEP reconstructions are performed per month. A busy stream of referrals can be expected from the ER, family physicians and the breast cancer surgeons

Anticipated weekday call commitments are I in 8 and regional weekend call is currently 4 per year.
