Program Description:

The Division of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery at The Hospital for Sick Children (SickKids) in Toronto, Canada, offers a comprehensive 12-month Paediatric Plastic Surgery Fellowship. This program provides advanced training in all aspects of paediatric plastic surgery.

Fellows will gain experience in a wide range of cases including congenital hand differences, facial paralysis, brachial plexus injuries, congenital nevi, burns, microtia, cleft lip and palate, vascular anomalies, tumour-related conditions, developmental abnormalities, oncologic cases, and post-traumatic deformities.

The program is led by Dr. Molly Jakeman and includes mentorship from Drs. Fisher, Wong, Fish, Davidge, Gus, Jakeman, and Mosa. Fellows participate in surgeries, clinics, on-call duties, and teaching. Completion of a research project is a requirement of the program.

- Eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO) and for a Canadian work permit

Preferred Qualifications:

- Completion of U.S. National Board Exams or Canadian LMCC/MCCQE1
- Demonstrated commitment to paediatric plastic surgery in home country
- Evidence of academic and research engagement
