The Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care London, is seeking one (1) Adult Plastic Surgeon.

Position Profile: This position is for a 12-month Term (Locum Tenens) position with potential for it to become a limited-term, clinical academic position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. The candidate will be responsible for breast reconstruction, including microsurgical based reconstruction. The incumbent may also have the opportunity to apply for a Clinical Adjunct appointment in the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University.

Academic and Clinical Expectations: The successful candidate must have a strong interest in breast reconstruction. The candidate will be based out of University Hospital but will also be responsible for rotating city-wide weekend coverage of general plastics call. The candidate will also provide site specific coverage at University Hospital, supporting other surgical services including Neurosurgery, Cardiac Surgery, and Orthopedics. The successful candidate will be expected to participate actively in the Division's academic, research and education initiatives including teaching and supervision of undergraduate students, postgraduate trainees, and fellows.

Qualifications: The successful candidate must have an MD or equivalent; have completed an accredited plastic surgery training program; have advanced training in breast reconstruction or demonstrate clinical experience in breast reconstruction; and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. Preference will be given to applicants who hold certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or the American Board of Medical Specialties.

Clinical Environment: The Division of Plastic Surgery is affiliated with London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care London. The Division has outstanding education and research programs while serving the region for tertiary/quaternary patient care. The Division of Plastic Surgery has an accredited Royal College residency training program and consists of 11 full-time faculty, 13 residents, and fellows providing care across three hospital sites.

Compensation: Compensation for this position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience and will be primarily composed of fee for service (OHIP billings) and HOCC payments (Hospital on call coverage).
