Description:

The Pediatric Craniofacial Surgery Fellowship at The Hospital for Sick Children (SickKids), affiliated with the University of Toronto's Division of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery, provides advanced subspecialty training in the full spectrum of pediatric craniofacial conditions.

Fellows will gain extensive experience in:

- Craniosynostosis (open and endoscopic approaches)
- Complex congenital craniofacial anomalies
- Orthognathic surgery in the pediatric population
- Cleft lip and palate surgery
- Facial trauma and post-traumatic reconstruction
- Benign and malignant pediatric head & neck pathology

Training is primarily based at SickKids, a high-volume international referral center for pediatric craniofacial disorders. Fellows participate in operative care, multidisciplinary clinics, research, and teaching. The program emphasizes surgical excellence, clinical decision-making, longitudinal patient management, and academic productivity.

Requirements:

Applicants must have successfully completed residency training in Plastic Surgery and be eligible for an Educational License from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). Detailed CPSO requirements can be found here:

Language Proficiency:

International Medical Graduates (IMGs) whose medical school language of instruction was not English must meet one of the following English proficiency requirements:

- TOEFL-iBT: Minimum overall score of 93, with a minimum of 24 in the speaking section.
- TSE and TOEFL (paper/computer-based): Passing scores from prior versions of the TOEFL are also accepted.
