

# ALLERGAN BREAST RECONSTRUCTION

## Description:

The University of British Columbia Division of Plastic Surgery, in conjunction with Allergan Canada, offers a 6-month Breast Reconstruction Fellowship.

This advanced training program is 6 months in duration and provides a large volume experience in immediate and delayed alloplastic and autologous breast reconstruction. Although a significant portion of the reconstruction is microvascular in nature, this is not a microsurgical fellowship. Rather, this is a comprehensive breast reconstructive fellowship for plastic surgeons that have completed their training and wish to develop/refine subspecialty skills in the management of breast and trunk reconstruction.

## Requirements:

Successful completion of a Royal College or American Board-certified Plastic Surgery program or equivalent.

Successful completion of the [TOEFL](#) exam if language of instruction and practice during medical school and residency was not in English. A passing grade must be obtained **prior** to submission of the fellowship application.

## Applications:

**NOTE** -The University of British Columbia (UBC) has had a late cancellation for their plastic surgery breast reconstruction fellowship for January 2022. **UBC is now taking applications** for a 6-month position starting in January 2022.

Applications are now being received for upcoming positions. Please apply ~ 24 months prior to the desired date of training. Applicants are generally accepted 18-24 months prior to the January or July start date.
