The Division of Plastic Surgery, Trillium Health Partners (THP), invites applications for an academic **Plastic Surgeon with specialization in Hand and Wrist Surgery**. The successful applicant will be based primarily at the Queensway site of THP.

THP is the largest community-based academic health network in Ontario serving over one million residents in the communities of Mississauga, Peel Region, and West Toronto. The hospital encompasses three main sites – Credit Valley Hospital; Mississauga Hospital; and Queensway Health Centre (QHC) – offering a full spectrum of surgical services and performing over 17,000 inpatient procedures and over 45,000 outpatient procedures per year.

THP's Plastic Surgery Division consists of 7 Plastic Surgeons and provides service to the City of Mississauga and surrounding communities. We provide specialized care in all domains of Plastic Surgery and are affiliated with University of Toronto and specifically the Mississauga Academy of Medicine. THP is a major provider of both acute and elective hand and wrist care in Ontario and there is the opportunity for third party physician/surgeon services at THP Insight Health Solutions. As such, THP's goal is to continue to advance our upper extremity program and are seeking a hand and wrist surgeon.

The role description for the successful applicant: practice will focus on hand and wrist surgery, 90% of surgical time dedicated to upper extremity surgery, supporting the delivery of unplanned care, contributing to medical education and clinical research. Additional qualities include experience/demonstrable interest in any one or more of the following: clinical/applied research, quality improvement, innovation, and healthcare technologies/AI. Excellent interpersonal and leadership skills and a commitment to team based and interprofessional care are essential as well as a responsibility to advance the strategic goals and vision of the Division of Plastic Surgery.

Remuneration will be on a fee-for-service basis through billings submitted by the physician to Ontario Health Insurance Plan. There is also the opportunity to join the Worker Safety Insurance Board hand program and offer WSIB expedited surgery. The successful candidate will care for surgical inpatients and outpatients and participate in the on-call rotation supporting Trillium Health Partners and surrounding Hospitals.

THP is an academic teaching hospital affiliated with the University of Toronto (U of T) and the U of T-Mississauga campus Academy of Medicine, The candidate will be eligible for an appointment at the University of Toronto, Department of Surgery, Division of Plastic Surgery. The successful candidate would be expected to participate in teaching of undergraduate and postgraduate medical learners and therefore a focus on surgical education and educational scholarship is preferred.

Applicants must hold an MD or equivalent with completed training in Plastic Surgery and must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. This individual must have obtained the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Fellowship in Plastic Surgery or equivalent and have undergone recognized Fellowship training in Hand and Wrist Surgery. The application process will remain open until the position is filled. The anticipated start date is January 2023.

Applications must include a letter of interest, an up-to-date Curriculum Vitae, names and contact information of three referees. Select applicants will be invited for an interview. Applications are to be submitted via email to **by September 30, 2022**:
