**TORONTO, ON:** University of Toronto, in conjunction with St. Joseph's Health Centre (Unity Health Toronto) is seeking to hire a full time Plastic Surgeon to join our hospital.

St. Joseph's Health Centre is a 426-bed community-based Toronto teaching hospital in west-end Toronto, serving a core population of over 500,000. Through its affiliation with the University of Toronto, St. Joseph's is part of Unity Health, (along with St. Michael's Hospital and Providence Health Centre), and has a clearly stated vision to be 'the best community-based teaching hospital in Canada'.

The busy Plastic Surgery service is currently supported by four other diversely skilled surgeons for a planned future 1/5 call roster. Appropriate access to the main OR, minor OR and ambulatory clinic space is available. The plastic surgery group at St. Joseph's is renowned for its dedication to resident and medical student education and we seek to further bolster this value with a new hire.

Our clinical vision for the position includes adding a general Plastic Surgeon with a commitment to providing comprehensive general plastic surgery care to our diverse community, and an interest in breast reconstruction. A fellowship in microsurgical reconstruction would be considered an asset. The successful candidate will hold certification with the Royal College of Surgery of Canada (RCPSC) and be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). The successful candidate will be expected to apply for academic appointment in the Department of Surgery, Temerty Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto, and to participate in medical student and resident teaching and research. Remuneration is through fee for service billing and an on-call stipend.

The diversity of our workforce is at the core of our innovation and creativity, and strengthens our program. The Department of Surgery and Division of Plastic Surgery at St. Joseph's Health Centre strive to embody the values of respect, collaboration and diversity, and has a strong commitment to employment equity. We seek qualified candidates who share our commitment to equity and inclusion, who will contribute to the diversification of ideas and perspectives, and especially welcome applications from Indigenous peoples, members of racialized communities, persons with disabilities, women, and persons who identify as 2SLGBTQ+.
