Fraser Health Authority is seeking a general community Plastic Surgeon. The ideal candidate will have a strong interest in general community plastic surgery including trauma, breast, and skin cancer management. They will be responsible for establishing a plastic surgery presence for the Fraser Health Authority at Ridge Meadows Hospital.

Ridge Meadows Hospital is part of the Fraser Health Authority, BC's largest and fastest growing health authority. To accommodate the growing population of its community, expansion of services including plastic surgery has been initiated. Plastic surgery resources including access to elective OR time and ambulatory care/cast clinics. There are also opportunities to perform MSP cases in private facilities.

Outside of the hospital, the ability to get privileges at a world-class private surgery centres are available, allowing you to deliver private (non-insured/cosmetic) care.

The group is affiliated with the University of British Columbia with teaching opportunities for medical students and residents, though RMH is not a primary residency training site. Research is not mandatory but will be supported.

General plastic surgery call is currently 1 in 5, and a MOCAP agreement provides an on-call stipend. With the addition of RMH, the call will be 1 in 6. Call is shared with the Abbotsford Regional Hospital & Cancer Centre, Langley Memorial Hospital group and other hospitals in the Fraser East region.

Nestled amid the scenic beauty of the Fraser River and the Golden Ears Mountains, Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows provides a mild climate, numerous schools and playgrounds (inclusive of both public and top-tier private options) and a thriving arts community. The region is a haven for outdoor enthusiasts, offering popular activities such as horse riding, biking, and hiking with an extensive network of trails spanning hundreds of kilometres. Additionally, residents can enjoy water-centric activities like canoeing, water skiing, fishing, and swimming right in the local area. As part of metro Vancouver, Maple Ridge is a mix of big city and mountain town with close proximity to Vancouver International Airport (38 kms) as well as a 15-minute drive from the pristine trails and camping of Golden Ears Provincial Park.
