B. POSITION SUMMARY

The Division of Plastic Surgery at the Ottawa Hospital, in affiliation with the University of Ottawa, invites applications for a permanent full-time plastic surgeon with fellowship training in nerve surgery and hand surgery.

The ideal applicant must have completed at least a one-year fellowship which focused on hand and nerve surgery. It is expected that the applicant will join an established interdisciplinary nerve reconstruction program. In addition, the applicant must have a stated research interest and plan for research development. The following attributes are important:

1. An advanced degree in an area relevant to the applicant's research interest
2. Fellowship training in hand surgery and nerve reconstruction
3. A strong record of collaboration

C. REQUIREMENTS

- The candidate must be eligible for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or higher
- The candidate must be eligible for certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada as well as licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario in Plastic Surgery.
- The candidate must have coverage with the Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA).
- The successful candidate must have demonstrated outstanding knowledge, skills and ethical standards as evidenced by strong letters of reference
- Candidate must hold a one year fellowship focused on upper extremity and nerve surgery
- Candidate must be highly collaborative and capable of working with an interdisciplinary team involving multiple medical and surgical professionals

D. TERMS

Resources include access to clinic space with well-appointed minor surgery facilities, and main operating room time. There is a strong interdisciplinary clinic involving physiatry (EMG) with whom the candidate will work closely. In

addition, the candidate would have access to the rehabilitation center. Academic appointment through the University of Ottawa is anticipated.

E. Remuneration Details

Remuneration is fee for service. In addition, there is a divisional practice plan.
