

PRACTICE OPPORTUNITY

EDMONTON, AB: The Department of Surgery, Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry, University of Alberta and Alberta Health Services, Edmonton Zone, invites applications for a Burn and Plastic Surgeon with an academic appointment in the Division of Plastic Surgery. The primary site of practice for this position will be at the University of Alberta Hospital and the Firefighters' Burn Treatment Unit.

The Section of Plastic Surgery provides service to the City of Edmonton and surrounding communities, with specialized care in all aspects of Plastic Surgery including trauma and burn care. The Division of Plastic Surgery has a busy and comprehensive residency and specialty training program.

The successful candidate will have the opportunity to practice the full spectrum of Plastic Surgery in a busy tertiary care institution, working cooperatively with a multi-disciplinary team. It is anticipated that the applicant will have demonstrated training and expertise in the complete care of the burn patient with skills including wound care management and intensive care training. The successful applicant will have a job description which will include a commitment to clinical care delivery, education and research.

The successful candidate must hold Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons registration in Plastic Surgery. Applicants must have completed a Fellowship in Burn Care and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Alberta. Training in intensive care would be an asset. Preference will be given to applicants who hold a Master's Degree or PhD in a related research field with wound healing as an academic area of interest
